### **Concealed Carry Weapon (CCW) Application Check List**

Applicants must submit the following documents with the completed CCW Application prior to further processing:

- Copy of current and valid California identification, which reflects applicant's current address and other identifying information
  
- Copy of the CCW range training certificate; that bears the business name, address, instructors name and certifying signature, the business license number and telephone number. CCW training that cannot be verified via the background process will be rejected. ***Range training to be taken after Live Scan has been conducted(New applicants only.)***
  
- Copies of any other CCW permits previously issued by other Law Enforcement Agencies (if still in possession).
  
- Investigators Interview Notes ***(Sections 1-5)*** is filled out in its entirety. ***Please complete this section prior to leaving your application with Jackson Police Department staff.***
  
- Applicant signature ***(Sections 7 & 8)*** to be done in the presence of Jackson Police Department personnel.

Upon review of your completed CCW application, you shall be notified of further processes; required by law for either issuance of or denial for a CCW permit.

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Learning the laws regulating the use of firearms is a must for responsible ownership. Local regulations differ and laws vary from state to state. Citizens must check with the jurisdiction where the firearm is to be used.

In California, the Chief of Police and staff are required to follow strict state and local guidelines when performing the necessary background checks for issuing concealed Carry Weapon licenses. Due to the detailed nature involved with conducting these background checks, appointment times and processing times can take multiple weeks.

If an applicant is **RENEWING** a Concealed Carry Weapon license in Jackson, they may not apply until **90** days before the expiration date listed on their current Concealed Carry Weapon license.

## **Concealed Carry Weapon License Requirements:** must meet **ALL** requirements

### Completing the Application

Answering all the questions on the standard application does not guarantee the issuance of a Concealed Carry Weapon license. The determination whether to issue the license is at the discretion of the licensing authority. Pursuant to California Penal Code section 26160, each licensing authority will have a written policy summarizing their requirements for issuance of a Concealed Carry Weapon license. In addition, prior to issuing a Concealed Carry Weapon license, the state statutes require proof that:

1. The applicant is of good moral character
2. The applicant meets residence requirements; and
3. The course of training prescribed by the licensing authority has been completed.

The applicant will certify under penalty of perjury that all answers provided in the application are true and correct to the best of their knowledge and belief. The applicant will also acknowledge that information disclosed on their application may be subject to disclosure.

### Training Required

If applying for a **NEW** Concealed Carry Weapon license, once the application has been approved by the Police Chief and the Live Scan process has been conducted, a 16-hour firearms training course must be completed.

If applying for a **RENEWAL** Concealed Carry Weapon license, completion of an 8-hour firearms training course is required prior to issuance.

### Authority

California Penal Code sections 26150 and 26155 provide that a Sheriff of a county or the Chief or other head of a municipal police department of any city, or city and county, may issue a license to carry a pistol, revolver, or other firearm capable of being concealed upon the person (Concealed Carry Weapon license).

### Who May be Issued a License

The licensing authority specified in Penal Code sections 26150 and 26155 (a Sheriff or the Chief or other head of a municipal police department) may issue a license to persons who are of good moral character, who have completed a course of training, and have good cause for issuance of a Concealed Carry Weapon license. All **NEW** applicants for a Concealed Carry Weapon license will be live scan fingerprinted and state and federal records will be checked to determine if they are eligible to possess firearms. **Beginning 9/1/2026** all applicants, new/renewal will be live scan fingerprinted and state and federal records will be checked to determine if they are eligible to possess firearms.
