### YOU MUST AGREE TO AND INITIAL ALL CONDITIONS OF PERMIT:

\_\_\_\_\_ You may burn only natural vegetation from your property

\_\_\_\_\_ Piles must be not larger than 4' x 4' x 4'

\_\_\_\_\_ Keep water available nearby

\_\_\_\_\_ Keep piles 50' from any structure and 10 ft diameter clearance

\_\_\_\_\_ A responsible adult must be always present

\_\_\_\_\_ No burning is allowed in the downtown historic district

\_\_\_\_\_ You agree that this permit does not relieve the user of any legal responsibility for the safe use of fire or allow burning to be done in violation of any state law, city or county ordinance, or fire department regulations restricting or regulating the use of fire.

\_\_\_\_\_ Piles larger than 4' x 4' x 4' must have approval from the air district and must be inspected by Jackson Fire Chief or their designee

\_\_\_\_\_ Burning is allowed within the City limits of Jackson following the lift on burning restrictions by CAL Fire in Amador County. The Jackson Fire Chief or their designee reserves the right to suspend burning at anytime

\_\_\_\_\_ You may be held responsible for all costs incurred as the result of any damage caused

\_\_\_\_\_ You must call the Amador County Air District at 209-223-6246 to see if it is a permissive burn day. Just because it is a burn day does not mean it is safe to burn, use discretion.
