MAINTENANCE WORKER I – Full Time, represented position

DEFINITION

Under direct supervision, to perform a variety of semi-skilled and unskilled tasks in the maintenance, repair, operation and improvement of streets, sanitary sewer, storm drainage and water systems, parks, public buildings, and related facilities; and to do related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF ESSENTIAL DUTIES

Operates trucks, hand tools and light power equipment, loads and unloads, lifts and carries material and objects, acts as groundskeeper and caretaker; sprays weeds and brush with chemicals; places traffic control and warning signs and serves as flagger; paints and installs street and traffic signs; paints street lines, crosswalks and curbs; cleans and maintains painting stencils; cleans and assists in repairs of storm drains, drainage ditches, streets, parks and sanitary sewers; observes safety precautions; reads water meters, maintain pressure valves, performs manual labor required to lift, load and haul equipment and materials; performs other related work as required. Position will be required to work shifts, weekends and/or holidays and a rotating on-call schedule.

QUALIFICATIONS

Training and Experience – Equivalent to the successful completion of high school and one year of experience in general construction or maintenance work involving the use of a wide variety of hand and power tools. Must be in good physical condition, able to perform heavy physical labor for extended periods.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities - Ability to operate trucks, hand tools and motorized equipment efficiently and safely; possess mechanical aptitude; physical strength and agility; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to work efficiently and cooperatively with others, and to maintain good appearance and relations with the public.

Licenses - Possession of an appropriate and unrestricted California Driver License at time of appointment and thereafter. Obtaining a Class B license upon completion of probation will be highly desirable.

Must live within 25-minute response time for on-call duties and emergency situations.

WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Work indoors or outdoors in a variety of environmental conditions, including heat, cold, dampness, humidity, dryness, dust, smoke, noise; work in, on, or around electricity or electrical items, gas, fumes, vibration, slippery or uneven surfaces, wastewater, ladders and scaffolds, confined spaces, water, and machinery; lift, carry, push, tug, and pull weights exceeding 50 pounds; walk, stand, crawl, kneel, bend, and use limbs repetitively; climb; operate motorized equipment; work with or in moving vehicles; reach above shoulder height; use fine motor skills to manipulate small objects; hear and comprehend simple oral and written communications in the English language; perform the essential functions of this classification.
